FICHE DÉCLARATION ENVIRONNEMENTALE ET SANITAIRE

FDES is an **environmental** and **health declaration for construction products.** As January 1st, 2022, it has been a compulsory requirement (only in France) for the sale of products in order to develop **Green and Healthy Buildings**.

The declaration is based on a **Life Cycle Assessment (LCA)** study, which evaluates the product's impact throughout its entire life cycle. Additionally, it provides valuable insights into the **potential indoor micro-pollution** resulting from the use of the product in question.

The service is developed in the following stages

- LCA study for the calculation of the environmental impacts of the product during its life cycle
- Integration of the LCA study with health information (e.g. radioactivity testing, metal release tests, etc.)
- Drafting of FDES document and submission to accredited assessor
- Support during verification and validation of the LCA and FDES study
- Support during FDES registration and publication in the INIES database
